In an effort to meet the guidelines set forth by House Bill 5, the Math Department at Western Texas College has determined that Querium TSI Math Prep is the most effective, efficient, and economical solution for schools to incorporate into their current math curriculum. This program is specifically designed to prepare students for the new TSI Math assessment. The program individualizes lessons to ensure each student is focusing on his or her own individual math weaknesses.

A flyer has been provided to help guide students in purchasing and accessing the program. The program cost is around \$30 per student. When prompted for the school, it is important that the students choose Western Texas College. The program contains 4 modules. The goal for each student will be to complete all 4 modules in a 16 week time frame, which means that the students are expected to complete one module every 4 weeks. Querium will provide Western Texas College and a designated high school representative a weekly student progress report.

At the end of the 16 week period the students will need to sign up to take the TSI Math placement test which costs \$10.
